2 table spoons of baking powder

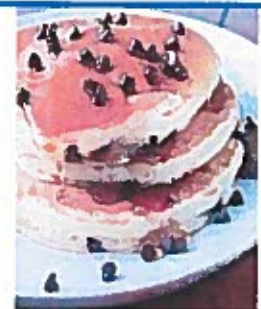
1/2 a teaspoon of salt

## **Chocolate Marble Cake**

### **Ingredients**

**225g butter, softened**

**225g caster sugar**

**4 eggs**

**225g self-raising flour**

**3 tbsp milk**

**1 tsp vanilla extract**

**2 tbsp cocoa powder**



### **Method**

**Heat oven to 180C/fan 160C/gas 4. Grease a 20cm cake tin and line the bottom with a circle of greaseproof paper.**

**If you want to make life easy, simply put 225g butter, 225g caster sugar, 4 eggs, 225g self-raising flour, 3 tbsp milk and 1 tsp vanilla extract into a food processor and whizz for 1-2 mins until smooth.**

**If you prefer to mix by hand, beat 225g butter and 225g caster sugar together, then add 4 eggs, one at a time, mixing well after each addition. Fold through 225g self-raising flour, 3 tbsp milk and 1 tsp vanilla extract until the mixture is smooth.**

**Divide the mixture between 2 bowls. Stir 2 tbsp cocoa powder into the mixture in one of the bowls. Take 2 spoons and use them to dollop the chocolate and vanilla cake mixes into the tin alternately.**

**When all the mixture has been used up (and if young kids are doing this, you'll need to ensure the base of the tin is fairly evenly covered), tap the bottom on your work surface to ensure that there aren't any air bubbles.**

**Take a skewer and swirl it around the mixture in the tin a few times to create a marbled effect.**

**Bake the cake for 45-55 mins until a skewer inserted into the centre comes out clean. Turn out onto a cooling rack and leave to cool. Will keep for 3 days in an airtight container or freeze for up to 3 months.**

## Banana Bread Recipe

Preparation time less than 30 mins

Cooking 30 mins to 1 hour

Serves 10

### Ingredients

285g plain flour

1 tsp bicarbonate of soda

½ tsp salt

110g butter, plus extra for greasing

225g caster sugar

2 free range eggs

4 ripe bananas, mashed

85ml buttermilk (or normal milk mixed with 1½ tsp lemon juice)

1 tsp vanilla extract

### Method

Preheat the oven to 180C/350F/Gas 4.

Sift the flour, bicarbonate of soda and salt into a large mixing bowl.

In a separate bowl, cream the butter and sugar together until light and fluffy.

Add the eggs, mashed bananas, buttermilk and vanilla extract to the butter and sugar mixture and mix well. Fold in the flour mixture.

Grease a 20cm x 12.5cm/8in x 5in loaf tin (2lb) and pour the cake mixture into the tin.

Transfer to the oven and bake for about an hour, or until well-risen and golden-brown.

Remove from the oven and cool in the tin for a few minutes, then turn out onto a wire rack to cool completely before serving.
